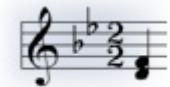

The choir helps inaugurate the annual Christmas Festival of Lights at the Washington DC Temple Visitors' Center. It also participates in the annual music festival sponsored by the Interfaith Council of Washington DC. The choir is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization.
