Founded in 1980, **THE MORMON CHOIR OF WASHINGTON DC** is composed of over 80 singers selected by audition, primarily from congregations of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia. The choir's mission is to worship God through music, testify of Him and His work, and support the interfaith outreach of the Church. The choir's repertoire includes a wide variety of secular and sacred music. The Mormon Choir has performed at the White House, Strathmore Music Center, Fort McHenry, Constitution Hall, Washington Monument, Kennedy Center, Washington National Cathedral, and many other religious and civic venues in the greater Washington area. New York Times best-selling author Chris Stewart recognized the quality and message of the choir in his recent book *Clear as the Moon*. The choir participates in music festivals sponsored by the Interfaith Council of Washington DC. It also helps inaugurate the annual Christmas Festival of Lights at the Washington DC Temple Visitors' Center. The choir is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization.
